Indoor Activities:

- Parents have your child help you get an Ice cube tray and add paint inside and freeze it. If you don't have paint, then add water and food coloring and put it in the freezer. Later once its frozen get it out and have fun painting with ice cubes. (see picture for reference)

Math:

- Go outside with sidewalk write numbers 1-10 and give your child spray bottle with water or a cup with water. Parent call out a random number and have your child go to that number and count to that number and try to erase it with the bottle or cup of water till the number disappears.
- Materials: Chalk, bottle spray with water, or a container to pour the water.
- In this activity they will count & learn number recognition. Using the spray bottle, it will help your child strengthen their fingers to prepare them for writing and holding pencils. (see picture)
