**Indoor Activities:**

- Make Fruit popsicles: Any fruit can be used for this! Simply have the children cut the fruit up and drop in the blender. Pour into popsicles molds and freeze.
- You can even pour into ice cubes trays, cover with plastic or foil and insert craft sticks into each compartment and then freeze. (see picture)

**Science: Chemistry – Magic Milk**

- Supplies: milk, food coloring (gel doesn't work), dawn dish soap, and cotton swabs.

Steps:

1. Start by pouring your milk into baking soda dish or another flat bottom surface. You don't need a lot of milk just to cover the bottom.
  2. Next, have the kids add drops of food coloring all around the milk.
  3. The kids will pick up a cotton swab and dip it in the dish soap.
  4. Then put the cotton swab in the milk- pressing it down in one spot and holding it there for about 15 seconds.
- Parents ask questions. What did you notice? What happened when you put the cotton swab in the milk? Why do you think that happened? Why do you think it stopped moving around after a period of time? What else did you observe?

**Outdoors:**

- Go outside on a walk and find flowers and freeze them. Let your child watch them melt in the sun or find new ways to make them. Freezing them in small bags or containers will help speed up the freezing process. (see picture)
